Digging Deeper: Group Questions & Personal Reflection

1. Peter lays out multiple, descriptive contrasts between Christians and “pagans”. Read through 1 Peter 2: 4 – 12 and draw them out.
2. For those who do not believe, the ‘stone’ is described as a “stone of stumbling”. What does that mean?
3. Read 1 Peter 2:12. We defined living a good life for pagans as a ‘mode of operation’ that is attractive, joyful, and full of life / wonder. But we all know Christians who are the very opposite. How can this be? Why do believers fail in this regard? Why is our reputation sometimes so stiff, dull, and boring?
4. Who in your group felt personally convicted in this challenge of attracting unbelievers? Would you share what that looks like for you?
5. Would you bravely give each other permission to confront each other if we ever begin to become like ‘Kevin’ from the message?
6. Pray for each other that we will partner with the Holy Spirit to become the kind of people who live good lives for all to see and glorify the Father.
